## **REQUIREMENTS**

- Applicants must be South African citizens. Preference will be given to Eastern Cape unemployed youth residents, from designated groups.
- Less than 3 months old proof of residence from local municipality should accompany the application.
- Applicants must provide proof of admission/ provisional admission/ proof of registration from a registered Higher Education Institution.
- For financial assistance eligibility, the applicant must demonstrate that his/her family combined annual household income is R350 000.00, or less/ a combined annual household income of R600 000.00 or less for applicants with disabilities. Proof/s of income and /or an affidavit on family financial status and a copy of parent/s or guardian's identity document.
- Applicants must also indicate if they are sponsored by another organization and provide proof thereof.
- Successful applicants should be prepared to work/ serve the Eastern Cape Department of Rural Development and Agrarian Reform as part of their contractual obligation, for a period equivalent to their funded study time.
